Headcodes

A headcode is a 4 character reporting code assigned to each train and used by various industry departments. The first character is a number that represents a trains category (shown below). The second character is a letter, and represents the route a train takes.

The third & fouth characters are incremental digits that identify a specific train.

- Class 1 trains usually represent express services 1
- 2 Class 2 trains usually represent local stopping services
- Class 3 trains usually represent a higher priorty Empty Coaching Stock (ECS) move 3
- Class 5 trains usually represent standard & lower-priority ECS moves 5 Other classes of train represent freight and some departmental services

Train Operating Companies (TOCs)

Trains in this timetable are run by the following TOCs

SW South Western Railway

- B Seat reservations are compulsory on this train.
- Seat reservations are recommended on this train. R
- Seat reservations available. This symbol is also used for 'counted places' (a system used for advanced ٥

- 1 First class accommodation is conveyed on this train.
- Sleeping berths and first class seating are available on this train. Reservations compulsory. É.

Timing Load / Traction

Most journeys contain timing load and traction details. These records are used for scheduling purposes and help to differentiate between slower & faster trains. As a result, shown traction is not guaranteed to operate and is sometimes erronerous, but can give an overview of what to expect.
