Days of Operations

Days of operation codes are made up of two portions. The first is the day (or days) relevant to the train, and the second is whether the train runs, or doesn't run on these days.

M Monday **O** Only

T Tuesday **X** Excepted

W Wednesday

Th Thursday **Examples**

F Friday **MO** - Monday Only

S Saturday **ThX** - Thursdays Excepted (does not run on Thursdays)

Su Sunday **TWO** - Tuesdays and Wednesdays Only

BH Bank Holidays **BHX** - Bank Holidays Excepted (Does not run on Bank Holidays)

Headcodes

A headcode is a 4 character reporting code assigned to each train and used by various industry departments.

The **first** character is a number that represents a train's category (shown below).

The **second** character is a letter, and represents the route a train takes.

The **third & fourth** characters are incremental digits that identify a specific train.

1 Class 1 trains usually represent express services

2 Class 2 trains usually represent local stopping services

3 Class 3 trains usually represent a higher priority Empty Coaching Stock (ECS) move

5 Class 5 trains usually represent standard & lower-priority ECS moves

Other classes of train represent freight and some departmental services
